

What is Single Stream Recycling?

- Place all of your recyclables together into your recycling container.
- Include paper, glass bottles and jars, metal cans & plastic *household containers*.
- Cardboard may be broken down if needed to fit in recycle container.
- Do not force materials into recycling container. It may not empty completely.
- No need to separate materials.
- Please be sure all containers are emptied of food and liquid prior to recycling.

Prohibited Materials

Do not place the following items in your recycling container:

- Plastic bags • Garbage • Liquid waste
- Food contaminated paper
- Window glass or lightbulbs
- Ceramic or stemware
- Hazardous Waste including:
 - Motor Oil or Filters
 - Automotive Batteries
 - Solvents • Paints and thinners
 - Pesticides and herbicides

What to Recycle:

Paper Products

*Flatten or cut boxes to fit loosely inside cart.
Put shredded paper in paper bags inside cart.*

YES

- ✓ White & Colored Paper
- ✓ Office Paper & Envelopes
- ✓ Newsprint, Inserts & Junk Mail
- ✓ Magazines & Catalogs
- ✓ Phone Books & Paperbacks
- ✓ Cardboard

NO

- ✗ Napkins, Towels, Tissues
- ✗ Food Contaminated Paper
- ✗ Pizza Boxes
- ✗ Photographs or Blueprint Paper
- ✗ Hardcover Books
- ✗ Waxed Cardboard or Paper



Milk Cartons, Juice and Soy/Rice Milk Boxes

*Empty before recycling.
Remove straws & tops.*

YES

- ✓ Milk Cartons
- ✓ Drink Boxes
- ✓ Frozen Food Packaging

NO

- ✗ Plastic Lined Cartons
- ✗ Straws or Pop Tops
- ✗ Liquids or Food Waste



Glass Bottles and Jars

Empty before recycling.

YES

- ✓ Food & Beverage Glass
- ✓ Clear & Colored Glass

NO

- ✗ Lightbulbs, Ceramic, Dishes or Stemware
- ✗ Window or Mirror Glass



Metal Cans

Empty before recycling.

YES

- ✓ Aluminum Cans
- ✓ Steel, Tin Bimetal Cans

NO

- ✗ Scrap Metal
- ✗ Car Parts



Plastic Containers

Empty before recycling.

YES

- ✓ Household plastic containers
- ✓ Milk & Water Jugs
- ✓ Soda & Juice Bottles
- ✓ Shampoo & Soap Containers
- ✓ Vitamin Bottles
- ✓ Yogurt, Deli, To Go Containers

NO

- ✗ Plastic Bags, Film or Wrap
- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Pipe, Buckets, Sheeting, Tarps
- ✗ Furniture, Pools, Baby Bathtubs
- ✗ Molded Plastic Parts
- ✗ Toys, Hangers or other Non-Container Plastics
